<u>Literacy – Winnie and Wilbur Under the Sea</u>

Remind yourself of our focus story — Winnie and Wilbur Under the Sea Winnie under the Sea - YouTube

Today, I would like you to imagine that you are Winnie or Wilbur. What information would you like to tell your family about your adventure under the sea? Can you create a postcard to send?

A postcard is a good way to tell a loved one what you have gotten up to on holiday. Some people like to collect postcards to showcase different photographs from different places they have visited or received them from. In your postcard you may want to draw a picture of the setting as well as write what Winnie and Wilbur have done so far and what they might do next (or an adult can scribe this for you).

Today we will be focusing on the digraphs 'oa' and 'or'. Can you think of words that contain these digraphs? For example, goat, boat, corn, torn. Write 2 lists of the words you think of.

As a challenge - can you read the sentences too?
