Trips and residentials should also be paid on ParentPay, paying by this method also gives permission for your child to attend.

Parking.

May I remind parents that no one should park or drop off children on the yellow zig-zag lines outside the school. This is a dangerous and illegal place to park especially when children are around. Parents should not park on Air Sea Containers premises or across their entrance. This could be a hazard in an emergency.

Attendance and Punctuality.

If your child is going to be absent, it is important that you inform the school on the first day of absence. Messages can be left on the absence line. School starts at 8.55am. All children should be in the school yard by 8.50am.

Parents of children who are persistently late and have high levels of absence will be invited in to school to discuss how this can be improved. The minimum attendance requirement for primary age children is 95%.

Collecting children early.

A number of parents are coming into the school office requesting to pick up children from school early. This should only happen in exceptional circumstances. Any appointments you need to make for your children should be made out of school time whenever possible. Should you need to collect your child early please note that we are unable to collect them prior to your arrival. Please leave plenty of time for them to be collected before your appointment.

Medication

Any medicines brought in to school must be clearly labelled with your child's name and dosage, with the pharmacy's original Label on the medication. Parents must complete a consent form giving permission for the medicine to be administered by a member of staff. Please also ensure that if your child has an inhaler at school that they are in date and that forms have been completed in the office.
