Year 4 & 5 Visit to Chester Zoo – Sustainable Palm Oil Challenge

Chester Zoo's Safari Ranger Outreach Team has been working with children in Year's 4 & 5 teaching them all about palm oil, what it is, how it's affecting wildlife and how we can all act for wildlife.

As part of this project the children will be visiting Chester Zoo on Thursday 06 December.

There is no charge for this trip therefore we will require the attached permission slip to be signed and returned back to school as soon as possible.
