Attendance and Punctuality.

Parking

Parents should not park on Air Sea Containers premises, parking across their entrance could be a hazard in an emergency and also blocks their vehicles.



Medication.

Any medicines brought in to school must be clearly labelled with your child's name and dosage, with the pharmacy's original Label on the medication. Parents must complete a consent form giving permission for the medicine to be administered by a member of staff. Please call into the school office at registration to hand in medication and complete forms.
