COVID 19 Re-opening Action Plan

Following communication with Parents and Carers, we expect the number of children of critical workers and vulnerable children to increase to 85 – 95 pupils from Monday 1 June 2020.

- Phase 2 includes Year 6 and F2 as we have two sites.
- Children of critical / key workers and vulnerable children will attend from 8:55 a.m. until 3:30 p.m.
- Designated year groups will have a staggered start and end to their day. We are planning the following start / end times: 8:45 a.m. until 2:15 p.m.

9:00 a.m. until 2:30 p.m.

9:15 a.m. until 2:45 p.m.

*we will notify parents on Friday 29 May 2020 of your start time

- All children will be organised into 'bubbles' and there will be three distinct bubble groupings:
 - Children of key / critical workers and vulnerable children (grouped within families)
 - Family bubbles
 - Pure year group bubbles (for children who have no siblings in school)
- There will be a maximum of 15 children per bubble, following the Government guidelines regarding social distancing.
- We believe that family bubbles will enable parents to bring their children to school safely and save time each day.
- Should children become ill, it will be easier to contain a possible outbreak of COVID-19 within bubbles.
- All children will be offered a packed lunch which will be eaten in their bubble.

Plans will be reviewed continuously reflecting current Government guidance and advice from the Local Authority.
