Year 6 will return Monday, Tuesday and Wednesdays from 15 June 2020

F2 will return Wednesday, Thursday and Friday from 17 June 2020

Important Information

Year 6 children without any siblings in school will start at 9:15am and finish at 3:15pm for three days – Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday. You will arrive at the gate nearest the Junior playground
Year 6 children with F2 siblings will start at 9:00am and finish at 3:00pm – Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday. You will arrive at the gate nearest the Junior playground

Year 6 children with siblings in school - F1, Year 1, Year 2, Year 3, Year 4 and Year 5, although their siblings are not returning until their proposed due date, will start at 9:00am and finish at 3:00pm – Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday. You will arrive at the gate nearest the Junior playground

F2 children without any siblings in school will start at 9:15am and finish at 3:15pm for three days — Wednesday, Thursday and Friday. *You will arrive at the Annexe main entrance* **F2 children with siblings in school - F1, Year 1, Year 2, Year 3, Year 4 and Year 5,** although their siblings are not returning until their proposed due date, will start at 9:00am and finish at 3:00pm — Wednesday, Thursday and Friday. *You will arrive at the gate nearest the Infant playground*

Please ensure social distancing at all times

- Parents / Carers are not allowed inside the school building or gates at the beginning of the day.
- Signage will be in place.
- As a raised temperature is one of the symptoms of COVID19, all children and staff will have their temperature taken before being admitted to the building. If a member of staff or child has a raised temperature they will not be admitted into school.
- Parents will collect their children from specified exits. At the end of the day parents are asked to queue from the gate identified where a member of staff will direct you to your exit to collect your child. This pick up point will not change.
- Each bubble will have a designated area with access to outdoors being strictly timetabled as bubbles are not allowed to mix.
- School will provide a packed lunch free of charge for those families in receipt of FSM and UIFSM. All other pupils will be charged £2.00 per day. Parents may choose to provide a healthy packed lunch for their child. Lunch boxes are NOT allowed as all items need to be disposed of after lunch. PLEASE REMEMBER WE ARE A NUT FREE SCHOOL
- From 15 June children from F2 and Year 6 in receipt of Free School Meals will receive a reduced amount of FSM vouchers. The vouchers will be issued for the days that the children are not expected to be in school. Parents will therefore receive vouchers to the value of £6 per child per week. The vouchers will be issued fortnightly in advance.
- Free School Meal Families If parents choose not to send their child to school on the days identified for their year group, school will provide a packed lunch for collection at the Annexe building:

F2 families should collect between the hours of 9:30 a.m. and 10:00 a.m. on Wednesday to Friday Year 6 should collect between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 10:30 a.m. on Monday to Wednesday

- Packed lunches provided from schools contain a fruit drink, cheese and crackers, a fruit pot, and a bakery item. The main choice is a sausage roll, or a sandwich, wrap or batch with the filling ham, cheese, chicken or tuna or a pasta pot with ham, tuna or chicken or cheese. Please inform school if your child has ANY allergies or food intolerances.
- Parents should provide drinks for their children as we cannot use the containers / beakers in school due to hygiene and cross contamination. PLEASE REMEMBER WE DO NOT ALLOW FIZZY OR ENERGY DRINKS.
- If your child is not attending school, you must inform the school office as registers will be taken and we must record levels of attendance for each child.
- Children cannot bring items from home into school e.g. balls, cuddly toys, backpacks or any school bags etc.
- Children are not expected to wear their school uniform.
- Please provide your child with a sun hat and apply sun cream to your child before school.
