Thursday and Friday from 24 June

#### **Important Information**

## F1 full day care or 30 hour children can access 2 full days per week F1 sessional children can access 2 mornings per week

- If your F1 child has a **sibling in Year 6** your **mornings / days** are **Monday and Tuesday** and you will come to main school using the gate nearest the junior playground at **9:00 a.m**. **Sessional F1** children must be collected at **12:00 noon**.
  - Full day care or 30 hour children must be collected at 3:00 p.m.
- If your F1 child has a **sibling in Year 1** your **mornings / days** are **Thursday and Friday** and you will come to main school using the gate nearest the infant playground at **9:00 a.m**.
  - **Sessional F1** children must be collected at **12:00 noon**.
  - Full day care or 30 hour children must be collected at 3:00 p.m.
- If your F1 child has a **sibling in F2** your **mornings / days** are **Thursday and Friday** and you will come to the front door of the annexe building at **9:00 a.m.** 
  - **Sessional F1** children must be collected at **12:00 noon**.
  - Full day care or 30 hour children must be collected at 3:00 p.m.
- All other F1 children will access Monday and Tuesday.
  - You will come to the front door of the annexe building at **8:45 a.m. until 11:45 a.m. if** sessional
  - You will come to the front door of the annexe building at **8:45 a.m. until 2:45 p.m. if full day** care or **30 hours**.

#### Year 1

- If your Year 1 child has a sibling in Year 6 your days are Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday and you will come to main school using the gate nearest the junior playground at 9:00 a.m. until 3:00 p.m.
- If your Year 1 child has a sibling in F2 your days are Wednesday, Thursday and Friday and you will come to the front door of the annexe building at 9:00 a.m. until 3:00 p.m.
- If your Year 1 child has no siblings you will access Wednesday, Thursday and Friday.
  You will come to the main building using the gate nearest the infant playground at 9:15 a.m. until 3:15 p.m.
- If your Year 1 child has siblings in F1, Year 2, Year 3, Year 4 or Year 5 You will come to the main building using the gate nearest the infant playground at 9:00 a.m. until 3:00 p.m.

\*\*\*Please ensure social distancing at all times\*\*\*

- Parents / Carers are not allowed inside the school building or gates at the beginning of the day.
- Signage will be in place.
- As a raised temperature is one of the symptoms of COVID19, all children and staff will have their temperature taken before being admitted to the building. If a member of staff or child has a raised temperature they will not be admitted into school.
- Parents will collect their children from specified exits. At the end of the day parents are asked to queue from the gate identified where a member of staff will direct you to your exit to collect your child. This pick up point will not change.
- Each bubble will have a designated area with access to outdoors being strictly timetabled as bubbles are not allowed to mix.
- School will provide a packed lunch free of charge for those families in receipt of FSM and UIFSM. All
  other pupils will be charged £2.00 per day. Parents may choose to provide a healthy packed lunch for
  their child. Lunch boxes are NOT allowed as all items need to be disposed of after lunch. PLEASE
  REMEMBER WE ARE A NUT FREE SCHOOL
- From 22 June children in Year 1 in receipt of Free School Meals (FSM) will receive a reduced amount of FSM vouchers. The vouchers will be issued for the days that the children are not expected to be in school (Monday and Tuesday). All eligible Year 1 families will therefore receive vouchers to the value of £6 per child per week. The vouchers will be issued fortnightly in advance. If parents choose not to send their child to school on Wednesday, Thursday and Friday, school will provide a packed lunch for collection at the Annexe building:

Y1 families should collect between the hours of and 10:30 a.m. and 11:00 a.m. on Wednesday to Friday

- Packed lunches provided from schools contain a fruit drink, cheese and crackers, a fruit pot, and a bakery item. The main choice is a sausage roll, or a sandwich, wrap or batch with the filling ham, cheese, chicken or tuna or a pasta pot with ham, tuna or chicken or cheese. Please inform school if your child has ANY allergies or food intolerances.
- Parents should provide drinks for their children as we cannot use the containers / beakers in school due to hygiene and cross contamination. PLEASE REMEMBER WE DO NOT ALLOW FIZZY OR ENERGY DRINKS.
- If your child is not attending school, you must inform the school office as registers will be taken and we must record levels of attendance for each child.
- Children cannot bring items from home into school e.g. balls, cuddly toys, backpacks or any school bags etc.
- Children are not expected to wear their school uniform.
- Please provide your child with a sun hat and apply sun cream to your child before school.
