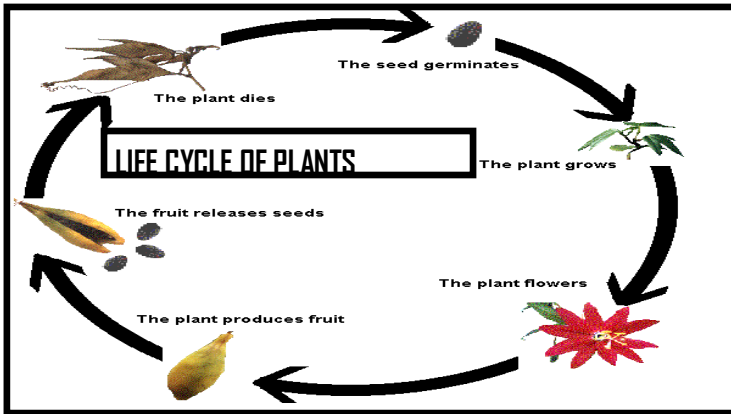


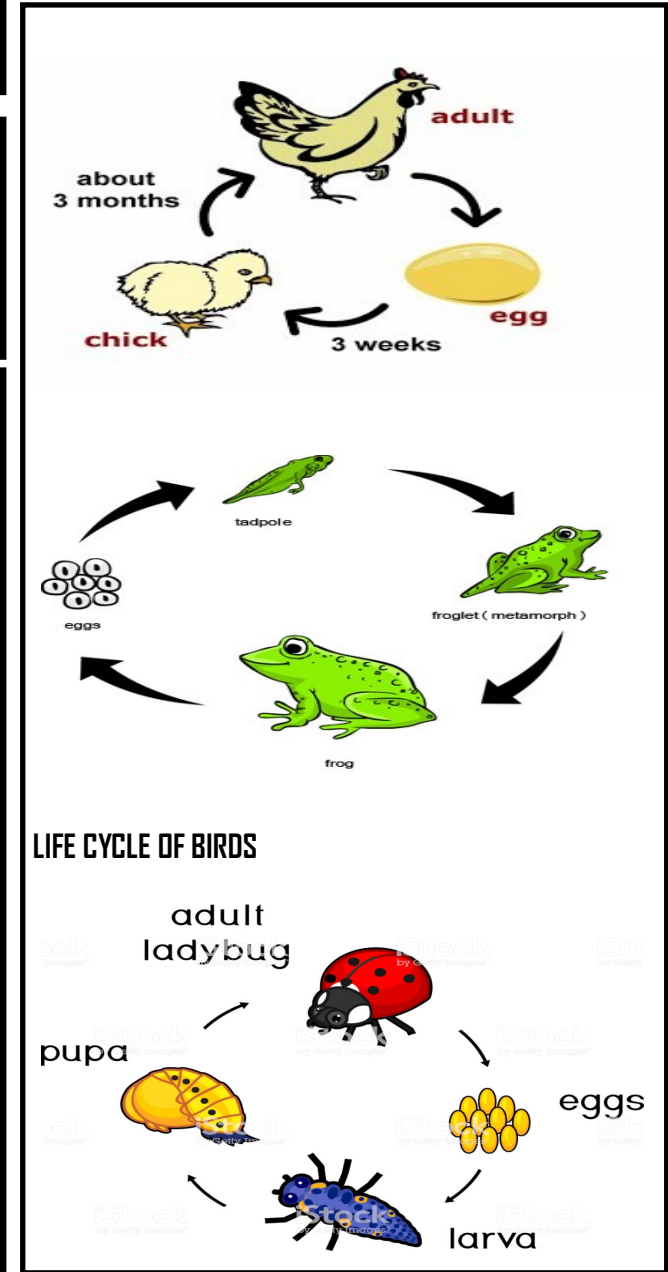

## LIVING THINGS AND THEIR HABITATS

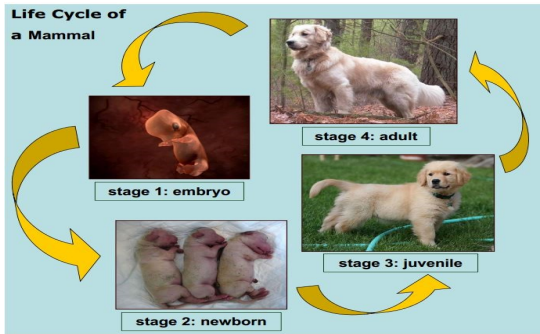


### LIFE CYCLE

A life cycle is made up of the stages a living thing goes through from birth to death.. These are different for different groups of animals.



### LIFE CYCLE OF MAMMALS



Mammals go through 4 main stages in their life cycle

- 1) Gestation – An embryo grows inside the mother, reliant on her for everything it needs.
- 2) Newborn– fed by milk from its mother, very dependent on parents for its needs
- 3) Juvenile – Growth and development independent from parents.
- 4) Adult – Seeks company in order to mate and nurse their own

### ANIMAL GROUPS

**MAMMALS:** warm-blooded, feed babies milk have live babies

**BIRDS:** have feathers and wings , lay eggs warm-blooded

**AMPHIBIANS:** live in water and on land, lay eggs , moist, slimy skin

**INSECTS:** hatch from eggs, some look like parents, shed skin and grow , some go through *metamorphosis* where young and adult look different.
