Literacy – Winnie and Wilbur Under the Sea

Talk about the story with someone at home. What happened in the beginning, middle and end? Where is the story set? Who are the main characters? What was your favourite part?

Winnie and Wilbur would like to go on another adventure. Where do you think they should go? Draw a picture of a new setting for Winnie and Wilbur's next holiday. Can you caption your drawing with a sentence, some key words or initial sounds?

Phonics – Spellings

Please practise your spellings. These can be found on Tapestry under the 'memo' section.

Maths – Halving

In Mathematics, we are continuing to learn about halving. Halving is when you split an object or number of objects into two equal sized pieces or groups.

Choose an **even** number up to 20 and find this number of objects e.g. 10 sweets. Can you halve the objects between yourself and a family member? How can you check if you are correct? Are both numbers equal? What is the half? "half of ___ is ___"

Repeat this a few times with different numbers.

This afternoon, we are celebrating England reaching the finals of the Euro's 2020. Have a chat with your family about why the country is celebrating this time, the importance of the national anthem, pride and resilience.
