This week, the children won't be sent home with a list of spellings to practise. We will have a number of spelling tests with the Common Exception Words for Year 1. This is a list of words that the children should be able to read and spell by the end of Year 1. We have been learning to spell these words in Phonics and English lessons, and the children have toolkits on their tables to help them with spelling these words. Some of these words can be segmented and blended, such as h-i-s... his. Others have to be learned by heart as they don't follow the usual spelling rules i.e. were. You may choose to practise some of these trickier words if you wish, but these tests are to assess what the children have retained so far. Spelling tests with these words will commence on 25.2.25 and will continue throughout the coming weeks.
