COMMON WILD PLANTS

A **wild plant** will grow by itself. It does not need to be cared for. If it grows where it is not wanted it may be a **weed**.

DECIDUOUS AND EVERGREEN TREES

Deciduous trees lose their leaves in the autumn every year. Their **leaves** are generally broad, flat and have veins running through them. **Evergreen trees** have green leaves all year round. Their **leaves** are generally thick, waxy and narrow like needles.

OTHER VOCABULARY

Branches -parts that grow out from the tree trunk and have leaves, flowers or fruit growing on them

Bulb—a root shaped like an onion that grows into a flower or plant

Herb- a plant whose leaves are used in cooking to add flavour to food or as a medicine

Petal—thin coloured or white parts which form part of the flower

Plant—a living thing that grows in the earth and has a stem, leaves and roots

Roots—the part of a plant that grows under the ground

Seed—the small, hard part of a plant on which a new plant grows

Stem— the thin, upright part of a plant on which the flowers and leaves grow
