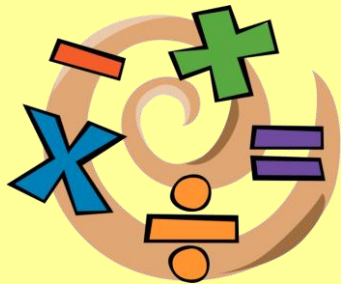


## Maths
