## COVID 19 Re-opening Action Plan

### **#If you have a child in more than one year group, your first child returning to school will start your family bubble.**

In this update we are outlining our plan to re-open the school to all pupils. The plan takes into account Government guidance and the practical details required to make these work in our School.

Our aim is for all pupils to have some time in a school environment before the long summer break. This will be full time for children of keyworkers and either 2 or 3 days for all other children. The school does not have the space to take all children full-time and maintain social distancing guidelines, so we feel this is the best compromise.

The key changes to a normal day are:

- In order to keep social distancing rules, children will be organised into 'bubbles' of up to 15 and will spend their school day within their bubble grouping. Each bubble will eat and play together and will have the same member of staff with them. Your child will be placed into a bubble according to these three criteria:
  - Children of key / critical workers and vulnerable children (grouped within families)
  - Family bubbles
  - Year group bubbles (for children who have no siblings in school)
- There will be a staggered start and end to the school day. You will be told your start and end time for your child.
- School will provide a packed lunch free of charge for those families in receipt of FSM and UIFSM. All other pupils will be charged £2.00 per day. Parents may choose to provide a healthy packed lunch for their child. Lunch boxes are NOT allowed as all items need to be disposed of after lunch. PLEASE REMEMBER WE ARE A NUT FREE SCHOOL

The school has been open to pupils of Key Workers throughout the lockdown and these pupils will still have priority. From the 8<sup>th</sup> June, the proposed plan is as follows:

**8<sup>th</sup> June - Year 6 and F2 children with a Year 6 sibling will return to the main building Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday**

**8<sup>th</sup> June – All other F2 children will return to the annexe building Wednesday, Thursday and Friday (due to family bubbles)**

**15<sup>th</sup> June – Year 1 will return to school Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday**

**15<sup>th</sup> June – F1 will return to the annexe building Thursday and Friday\***

**\*F1 information – All children entitled to 30 hours' childcare will attend school for 2 full days**

**\*F1 information – All children entitled to 15 hours' childcare will attend school for 2 morning**

**22<sup>nd</sup> June – Years 5 and 2 will return to school - details to follow**

**29<sup>th</sup> June – Years 3 and 4 will return to school - details to follow**

**The action plan will be reviewed regularly and at the end of each phase due to capacity and Government Guidance and may be subject to change**
