percussion

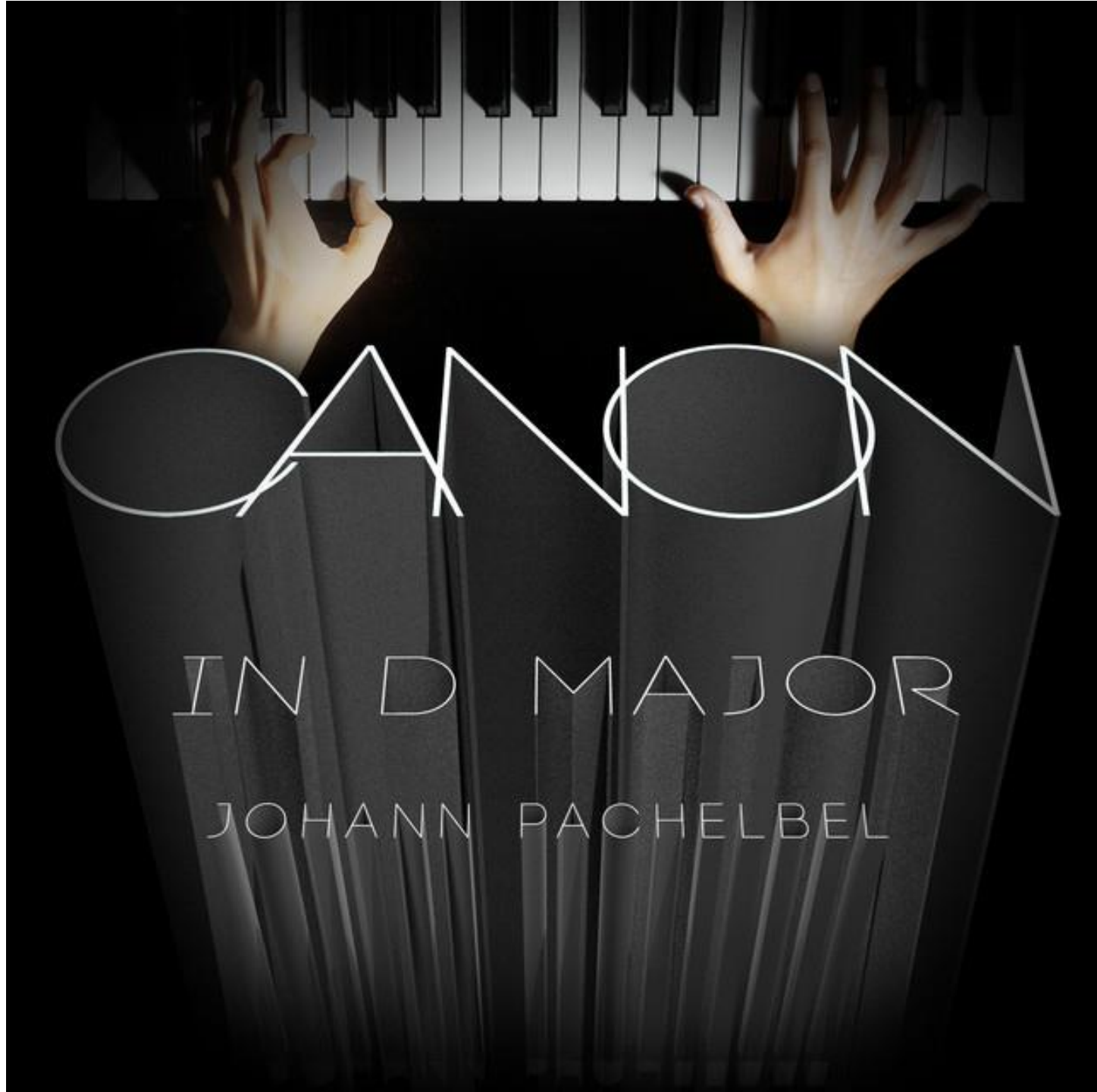

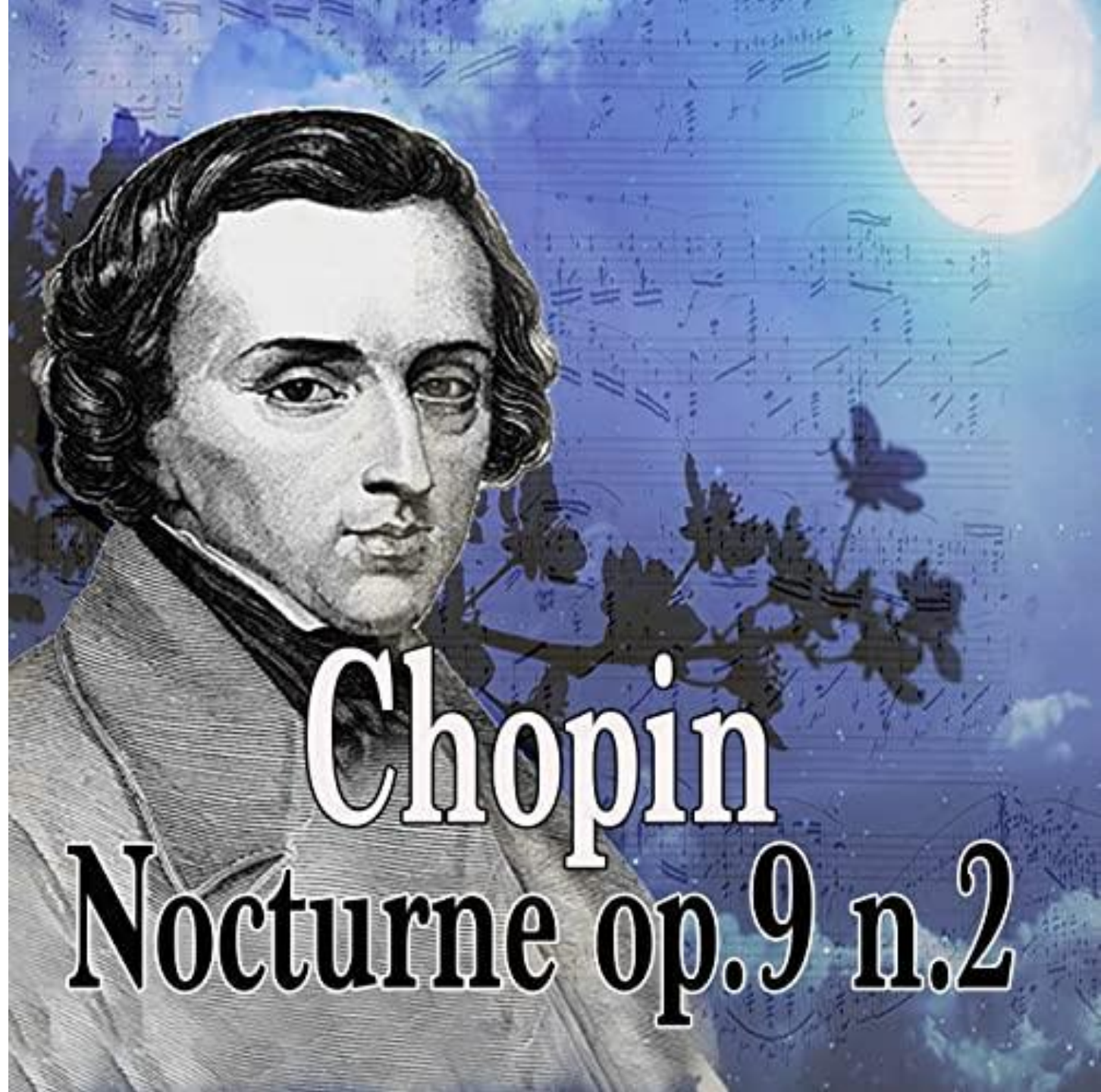
Day two: Canon in D Major – Johann Pachelbel

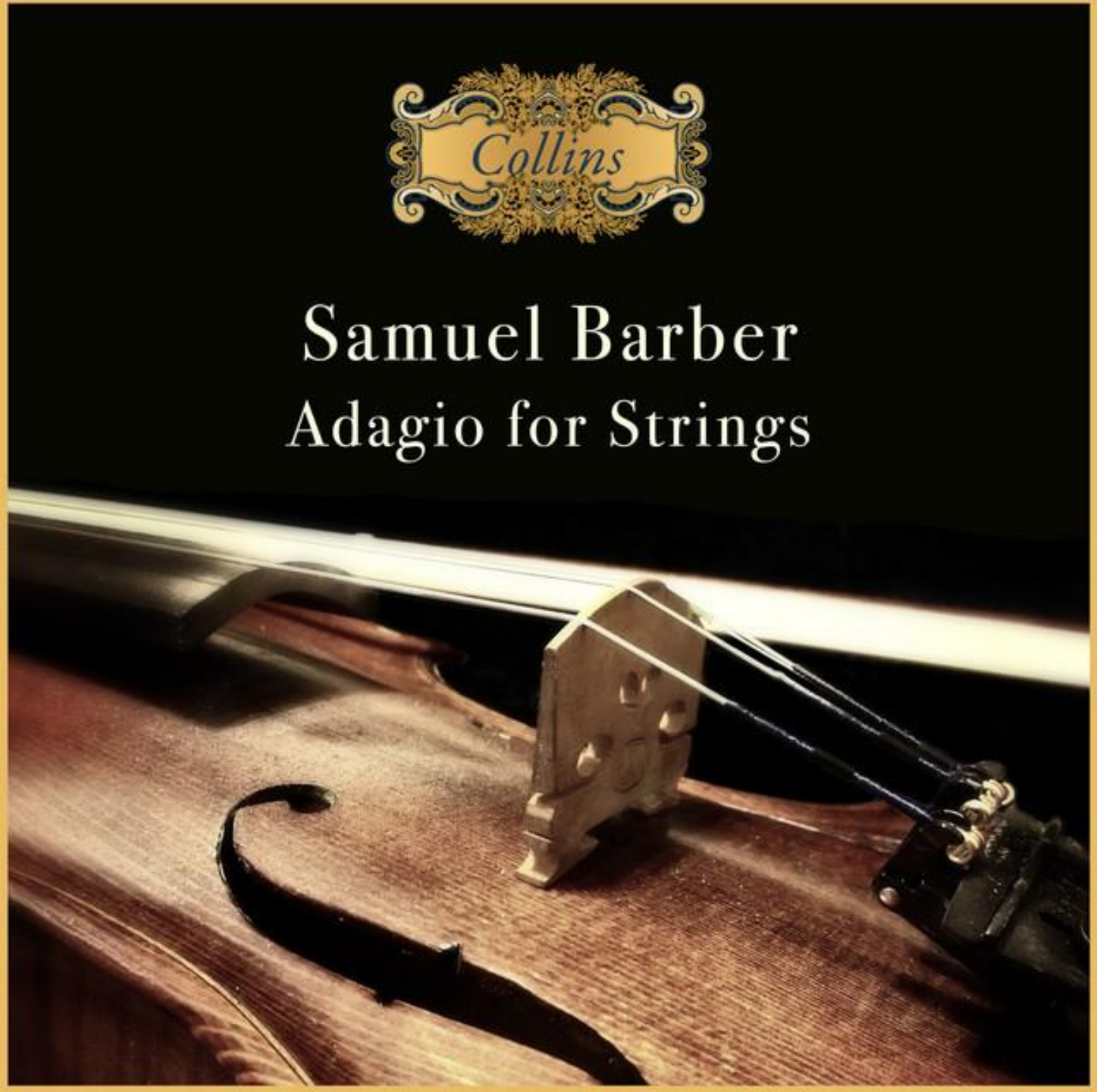
